|  | Operational employees must be at least in possession of a basic VCA certificate. Supervisors should be FULL VCA certified. Activities to be carried out in accordance with the VCA guidelines. |
|  | Safety helmet, appropriate work clothes and work shoes (S3) are always required. Other personal protective equipment is required for certain activities. |
|  | A permit to work is required when performing hot work, bunkering of oil, paint spraying, grit blasting work and overtime (work outside normal working hours). For a permit to work please call: + 31 620352987. |
|  | Within the company emergency responses are present. In case of any accident, incident or emergency, please call: + 31 184 676 144. |
|  | Housekeeping. We kindly request you to keep the company tidy. Waste is collected separately. In this way it can be recycled. The bins tell you what is allowed and what is not allowed to put in. It is not allowed to leave (environmental) hazardous waste unattended. |
|  | Alcohol and drugs are prohibited. This applies both to the possession as being under the influence of those drugs. Medication? Please report negative side effects before start work. Smoking is in any case prohibited on board off ships or near the ships. Tobacco and Smoking legislation is in effect. |
|  | Hazardous substances: inform yourself of the risks and dangers of the substance. Storage and use in accordance with the applicable (legal)rules. Protect yourself (PPE) and your colleagues against the adverse consequences. For example; adequate ventilation when creating smoke, dust and / or vapors. |
|  | Using machines, cranes, aerial and forklift; only with permission of Den Breejen Shipyard, only if you are adequately trained for this, only if the inspection date is OK, it is well-functioning and in safe condition. Electric (hand) tools: only use if they have been tested and visually ok. |
|  | Last Minute Risk Analysis. Before starting your job, enter a LMRA. The purpose of LMRA: All (potential) health, safety and environmental hazards are identified and adequately controlled to prevent accidents. |
|  | Report dangerous situations, almost-accident or incident to the SHEQ coordinator (+ 31 653137742). Why report? When something (almost) goes wrong, it can be seen as a warning. By taking appropriate action future accidents can be prevented. |
|  | Work in confined space bring additional dangers. Ask your supervisor for the rules applicable to working in a confined space. One of these rules is the mandatory wearing of personal gas meter and have an access measurement performed. |
|  | Use only lifting equipment that is inspected, functions well and is in a safe condition. |
|  | Lifting, carrying, pushing, pulling: physical load is ok. Physical overload is not okay and should be avoided. |

Additional information for captains on Den Breejen Shipyard

|  | If you are going to carry out work yourself on the ship, please contact us. Within our company we must comply with legal restrictions such as: preventing (noise) nuisance, protecting surface water, machine sanding only with dust collection etc. This also applies to work during the weekend and in the evening. |
|  | For (gas) tankers at Den Breejen Shipyard there are additional requirements. One of these requirements is to fill in document 7.5.3.01.04.01 "registration of tankers". Tankers may only be present in our harbor with a valid certificate from a gas doctor (marine chemist). |
|  | Exposure to asbestos is forbidden. Please indicate before starting work whether there is a chance of exposure to asbestos. |
|  | The use of shore power and (emergency) generating sets should be consulted. If a ship is docked, the use of a chain lock is mandatory. |
